UNIFORM/DRESS CODE

It is the parents' responsibility to keep the uniforms clean and in good condition.

Out of Uniform: If a student comes to school out of uniform, they will report to the office. At that time, a parent will be contacted and required to bring the appropriate clothing to school.

Uniform Violations: Violations of the uniform dress code will be handled as a discipline situation.

Below is a list of possible violations. It is the right of the administration to make adjustments at any time. Any changes will be made known to the parents in a note or via the "Parent Update".

Violations

- No unreasonably short skirts or shorts.
- No make-up. No lip gloss is permitted.
- No jewelry (boys and girls)
- No Bracelets, Necklaces, or Rings – One wrist watch is permitted
- No dangle or hoop earrings. Only post-type earrings; one per ear.
- No open-toed shoes, "jelly" shoes, sandals, flip flops, or clog type shoes. **Including Out-of-Uniform Day.**
- No nail polish of any kind or fake nails.
- No baseball caps or hats inside the building.
- No sweatshirts other than OLL official navy or gray **crew neck** sweatshirts. Plain navy or gray crew neck sweatshirts are acceptable. No hoods or pockets.
- No type of "pants" may be worn under girls' skirts during the school day. They may be worn to and from school, during recess, but they are not allowed during school hours.

General Uniform Boys K- 6

Shirt - White polo shirt with buttons (at least 3) and a collar. White turtlenecks with no insignia may be worn. T-shirts may NOT be showing from sleeves, neckline, or bottom of polo shirt. Only plain white T-shirts may be worn. No logos or writing.

OLL official sweatshirt and plain navy or gray **crew neck** only; no hoods or pockets. A plain navy cardigan or pull over sweater with long sleeves is also acceptable.

Pants - Navy blue dress/uniform pants with one or two back pockets. Belts are optional.

Socks - Solid plain white or any style solid navy socks may be worn.

General Uniform Boys 7- 8

Shirt - Navy polo shirt with buttons (at least 3) and a collar. T-shirts may NOT be showing from sleeves, neckline, or bottom of polo shirt. Only plain white or navy T-shirts may be worn. No logos or writing.

OLL official sweatshirt and plain navy or gray **crew neck** only; no hoods or pockets. A plain navy cardigan or pull over sweater with long sleeves is also acceptable.

Pants - Khaki dress/uniform pants with one or two back pockets. Belts are optional.

Socks - Solid plain white or any style solid navy socks may be worn.

Boys K- 8

Hair: Hair length must be above the shirt collar. Extreme hair styles are not allowed. No part of the head should be shaved with designs. No hair coloring; however, bleaching and highlights are at the parents' discretion.

Shorts: Students are allowed to wear uniform walking shorts from the beginning of the school year through the end of October. They may also be worn the remainder of the school year beginning April 1st.

General Uniform Girls K- 6

Shirt - Simple white button (at least 3) blouse or shirt with a collar. White Polo shirt or White turtlenecks with no insignia may be worn. T-shirts may NOT be showing from sleeves, neckline, or bottom of polo shirt. Only plain white T-shirts may be worn. No logos or writing.

OLL official sweatshirt and plain navy or gray **crew neck** only; no hoods or pockets. A plain navy cardigan or pull over sweater with long sleeves is also acceptable.

Vested Jumper K-4/ Skirt or Skort 5- 6: Purchased at Dennis Uniform in the OLL Navy plaid. (Skort is mandatory 2004-2005.)

Pants - Navy blue dress/uniform pants with one or two back pockets. No stirrups, elastic waist pull-on pants, or leggings allowed. Slacks may be worn throughout the entire school year. Belts are optional.

Skort- Grades 5 & 6. Purchased at Dennis Uniform in the OLL plaid. Needs to fit correctly and be acceptable length. www.dennisuniform.com (item #035210-201)

Shorts - Shorts must be navy blue walking shorts (no more than 3 inches from the top of the knee) with a waist band and zipper. White uniform shirts/blouses must be worn with the shorts.

Socks - Solid plain white or any style navy socks may be worn. Primary grades may wear navy or white tights - no leggings.

General Uniform Girls 7- 8

Shirt - Navy polo (at least 3) short or long sleeved. T-shirts may NOT be showing from sleeves, neckline, or bottom of polo shirt. Only white or navy blue T-shirts may be worn. No logos or writing.

OLL official sweatshirt- or plain navy crew neck only. Needs to fit correctly-not oversized. No hoods or pockets.

Skort : Purchased at Dennis Uniform in the OLL plaid. Needs to fit correctly and be the acceptable length. (No more then 3 inches above the knee)

Pants - Khaki dress/uniform pants purchased at Dennis Uniform. Belts are optional.

Shorts - Shorts must be khaki walking shorts (no more than 3 inches from the top of the knee) with a waist band and zipper. Navy uniform shirts must be worn with the shorts.

Socks - Any style of white socks or plain navy socks may be worn. Junior high grades may wear navy tights during the winter months only - no leggings.

Makeup - No makeup may be worn. No fingernail polish may be worn. No fake nails.

Girls K- 8

Hair: Extreme hair styles are not allowed. No hair coloring; however, highlighting and bleaching are at the parents' discretion. Head bands must be white, navy blue, or brown/black and no more than an 1 inch wide.

Jewelry: May only wear one earring (post type) per ear.

Shorts: Students are allowed to wear uniform walking shorts from the beginning of the school year through the month of October. They may also be worn the remainder of the school year beginning April 1st.

All Students PK-Grade 8

No Cell phones may be used during the school day hours. All cell phones must be turned off. If used during the day the teacher will it bring to the school office and the parent must pick it up.

No personal electronic/battery operated devices, (CD players, i-pods, Wii, Blackberries, Blackjacks, etc.) may be used in the school at any time.
