## Some Highlights of OLL

*Of the many opportunities to serve – Here are a Some:*

Coffee and Doughnuts are served each Sunday after Masses in St. Bernadette's Hall to provide hospitality and promote fellowship.

SCRIP certificates are sold for various restaurants and grocery stores.

Good News newspaper is published every month on the second Sunday of the month.

Home and School is a group of parents and teachers working together to raise funds and provide volunteer assistance for school-related programs and events.

Booster Club organizes sporting events for OLL and CCD students and neighborhood youth. This group provides financial support to athletics and extracurricular activities.

Lectors read liturgy and announcements at weekend Masses.

EMHCs distribute communion.

Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration is a spiritual program which has been ongoing for 25 years. 24 hours each day individuals pray before the Blessed Sacrament in one hour increments.

Legion of Mary helps further the holiness of the church. We visit shut-ins, nursing homes and hospitals.

Music Ministries – 9 a.m. choir provides 4-part harmony while the 11 a.m. Music Ministry Group provides contemporary liturgical music with guitar.

Knights of Columbus have events and activities, along with various fund-raisers, to provide assistance to others.

Fall Festival is held on the last Sunday of September. Over 350 people volunteer to work at the festival, which consistently becomes more successful each year.

Ministry to the Sick and Home-Bound is available at OLL. Holy Communion is brought to the homebound after the 9:00 Mass.

RCIA is a program for those people wanting to join the Catholic faith as well as those wanting to further understand their Catholic faith.



Our Lady of Lourdes Church was founded in 1918 with the establishment of the first classroom in 1924. For over 80 years, Our Lady of Lourdes and Her School has been an anchor in South Omaha. Over the span of those years, more than 3000 individuals have been educated in the foundations of our Catholic faith. Spreading across the entire United States and in many countries around the world, those people have greatly contributed to the betterment of our neighborhood and society.
